# The Garden Route

Much of this stunning stretch of coastline with mountainous back drop is protected by the **Wilderness** and **Tsitsikamma National Parks**. Whilst the region offers un-spoilt beaches, lagoons and forests as well as some excellent interactive animal sanctuaries, it is also home to sophisticated coastal resorts such as **Knysna** and **Plettenberg Bay**.

## Activities and Attractions

The Garden Route, known as South Africa's Eden, stretches from Mossel Bay in the West to Tsitsikamma in the East although here we also include part of the arid but beautiful Little Karoo, just in-land. A trip on the Outeniqua Choo Tjoe, a narrow-gauge train which steams over bridges and through plantations between Knysna and George, is a fun

and memorable way to gain an insight into this scenic region.

A host of activities, such as forested walking trails and boating on inland lakes, are focused on the pristine natural environment, whilst swimming for children can ideally be enjoyed in the tranquil lagoons and estuaries, such as those found at Nature's Valley.

Travellers looking for something more adventurous can try a Tree Canopy Tour, or even the highest bungee jump in Africa, off the Bloukrans Bridge!

Excellent wildlife sanctuaries also enable visitors to get close to South Africa's terrestrial wildlife, such as Knysna Elephant Park and The Elephant Sanctuary, where guests can feed and learn more about the residents.

Monkeyland near Plettenberg Bay is the world's first free roaming multi-specie primate sanctuary whilst Birds of Eden close by, is a free-flight bird haven, encompassing 2 cubic hectares of forest.

Dolphins are resident in the waters year round, whilst whales follow the coast on their annual migration between June and November.

Plettenberg Bay offers boat trips for closer sightings.

At the foot of the Swartberg Mountains in the Little Karoo, Oudtshoorn provides a good base for visiting the Cango Caves, Cango Wildlife Ranch and the nearby Ostrich Farms where you take an unusual ride!




## Accommodation

There is a wide selection of accommodation on the Garden Route, generally based near Knysna, famous for its expansive lagoon and oysters, or the attractive beaches of Plettenberg Bay.

It is possible to base yourself in one location and day trip to all the attractions mentioned above whilst many also offer a range of activities on site from horseriding to boating. A number of the hotels also have particularly good facilities for children such as outdoor play areas as they are set in large gardens.

## Accommodation
